

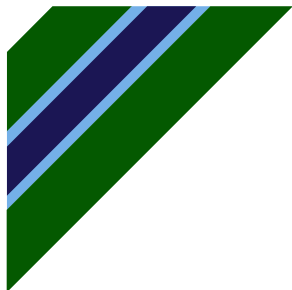

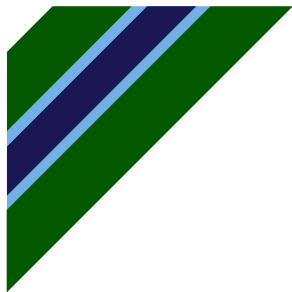

2. Minutes

The minutes of the Annual General Meeting of 5th January 2024 were circulated, approved and signed.

3. Annual Report

The President invited the Captain to present his annual report.

The Captain presented an overview of the season, mentioning highlights such as the Tatum Tour to San Francisco Golf Club and Cypress Point Club; the match against Harvard & Yale in the Boston area; and the trip to Belfast and Portrush to play the QUGS.

Whilst match results in the first half of the year were best not mentioned, those in the second half were much better. Special mention was made for Minnow Powell overseeing a particularly strong performance against the Windcheaters. He mentioned the spirit in which matches are played as being the essence of serious fun and encouraged members to play in matches over the coming year.

Fourteen new members were elected to the Society this year, and it was particularly pleasing to see the appointment of Chloe Royston as captain of CUGC, the first woman to captain either university team. He complimented Peter Jackson on the continued fine quality of his play in senior golf and noted the enthusiasm that Carl Heneghan has brought to his role as the new senior member for OUGC, and his hole in one earlier in the day on the 2nd on the Jubilee.

He noted that last year's Varsity Match at Rye was a great success and he encouraged members to attend this year's match at Royal North Devon. A tour is planned to the North West region later this year, and Peter Pentecost was thanked for his help with the organisation. He also expressed his appreciation for Roger Kelly's organisation of the Dinner, and the efforts of the Hon Treasurer, the Hon Sec, Minnow Powell and the Speed Trust board, and finally Clive Edginton as outgoing President.

4. Presentation of Accounts

The President invited the Hon. Treasurer to present the Society's accounts for the year to 30th September 2024. The Hon. Treasurer made brief mention that:

- the Society's operating result was very satisfactory, with a modest surplus for the year.
- Match expenditure was increasing year-on-year but this reflected an increasing number of younger members participating in matches and receiving subsidies, which was to be welcomed.

The President thanked the Hon. Treasurer for his work during the year.

5. Speed Trust Report

The Chairman, Minnow Powell, noted that income had exceeded expenditure during the year and the balance sheet of the Trust remained strong.

The President thanked Minnow Powell for his continued efforts and leadership of the Speed Trust.

6. Election of Officers and Committee members

The Captain thanked Rye Golf Club and its staff for accommodating us during the Putter and thanked the bar staff in particular for their great service. He closed the meeting by encouraging fast play during the Putter and stated that the draw for the Secretary's Niblick would commence in five minutes.
